Reading Challenges

Reading is for Everyone!

Over the summer, the Library provides a variety of challenges to stretch all levels of readers. Join in the fun with these self-paced challenges!

Ages 0-5, track books as a part of "1000 Books Before Kindergarten," available throughout the year. To get started, pick up a 100 bubble sheet. Fill in a bubble for each book read - and if a favorite book is read 10 times it counts for 10 bubbles! When you complete a sheet, return it to the Library for a sticker & take your picture for our wall of readers. Once you reach 1000 books, another prize is earned for reaching this achievement!

Kids 12 & Younger, pick up a Summer Reading Program Booklet to track minutes read and earn great prizes from our community sponsors. Depending on your age, challenge yourself to read different amounts of time each day, from 10 minutes daily for beginning readers to 60 minutes daily for a SUPER EXTREME Reader!
